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Best practice-I

Title of the practices: Blood donation campaign for Social Welfare

Objectives of the Practices

We need 12 million units of blood every year but just about 9 million units are being donated. The primary objective of the blood donation camp was to address the ongoing blood shortage in local hospitals and medical facilities. By encouraging community members to donate blood, the aim was to replenish blood supplies and potentially save lives. Our college has been religiously organizing blood donation camps every year and students and the faculty members come forward voluntarily to donate blood. While addressing to people at the camp our NSS volunteers brought awareness in them about shortage of blood and why we must donate blood every year, to help the persons requiring blood. Blood donation can save lives of innumerable persons. Donation of blood is very critical and crucial for saving lives many patients and those who have met with accidents. It is as such a great service or contribution to the society and people living in it.

The context

Our institution is located behind Govt. PG College, Karauli, Rajasthan. Blood donation camps are those camps where blood is obtained from suitable healthy donors for people of various blood groups who are in need of blood. Many organizations conduct blood donation camps on a regular basis. Many people/patients have conditions like thalassemia, cancer or other life-threatening diseases. These types of diseases often demand blood infusions during the course of treatment. If patients suffering from ailments receive the right type of blood, their lives can be saved.

The practice

A blood donation camp was organized by NSS district nodal center Govt. PG College, Karauli. The function started around 9 o'clock in the morning with a Ribbon Cutting by Honorable Principal, Vice-Principal, District Collector, SDM, CMHO Karauli, NSS Co-Ordinator and other respected faculty members.

The students of the college too participated in the program. The blood collected from this camp was to be given to the Government Hospital. The college had arranged for refreshments for those who donated blood in the camp. Students and other people who had participated in this blood donation camp were given certificates and a small gift hamper. To watch over the entire process and to collect the blood, a team of doctors were put in charge. The college had also arranged for a resting room for anyone who felt dizzy or sick after donating blood. Volunteers from a local club also had come to help the college organize the blood donation camp.

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After the completion of the blood donation, the principal thanked and appreciated everyone present in the camp. The day ended with the National Anthem and a heartfelt vote of thanks from the principal of the college.

Evidence of success

This Blood donation camp was organized by our institute, in collaboration with Govt. PG College and Govt. Hospital Karauli, through which more than 65 units of blood was donated. In this campaign total 65 volunteers were donated blood. Out of 65 candidates six candidates of our institute, fifty candidates of Govt. PG College and others donated blood.

Problems Encountered and resource required

Our institution mainly faced challenges such as, Fear of needles, sight of blood, Fear of ill effects, objection from elder and never been asked for blood donation. The most common of them were fear of ill effects and never been asked for blood donation. Most of the students who were willing to donate, but they had not donated blood because of a lack of opportunity to do so. This campaign showed that sufficient steps to involve students, to create opportunities for them to donate blood is something that needs to give due consideration. Among most first-time donors temporary deferral becomes the permanent excuse for not donating blood. In another way our society parents have a wrong concept that blood donation causes weakness and hence they have a discouraging attitude toward the donation of blood by their children especially by girls. Experience of blood donation is an important factor for determining future blood donations, especially in first time Blood donors.

Title of the practices: Tree Plantation in college campus

Objectives of the Practices
